1. Cost of certification includes inspector's labor, inspection documentation, and annual inspection decal.
2. Rates are based on "typical" jobs and may be increased at the discretion of Montana Crane Service's inspectors and/or management. Factors that may increase the rate of any inspection include, but are not limited to: site conditions, access to the lifting device, and extensive issues/damage to the hoisting mechanism.
3. Load testing is not included in the listed certification costs. Load testing is available and will be quoted per job requirements.
4. Customer is responsible to provide safe access to hoisting mechanism on all overhead type cranes (man lift, bucket truck, etc.). In the case that Montana Crane Service, Ltd. is expected to provide access, the cost of the rental will be billed at cost plus 15%.
5. Overtime will be charged for hours before 6 A.M. and after 6 P.M., and over eight hours on a one site.

## SPECIAL NOTES & BILLING POLICIES

- Listed rates are for short term projects, discounted rates may apply depending on the duration of the project. Written and verbal quotes are available upon request for all your lifting needs.
- Cranes are priced by the hour based on all time onsite and round trip travel "portal to portal" with minimum charges applied to most quoted projects.
- Overtime charges are added to the listed hourly rates under the following conditions:
  - All hours before 6am and after 6pm.
  - All hours past 8 hours on one job site.
  - All Weekend and Holiday hours including: Christmas, New Years, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Memorial Day, Labor Day and Thanksgiving
- Manned standby time for cranes and equipment will be charged at 60% of the listed hourly rates, labor will be charged at the listed rate. Un-manned standby for equipment will be charged as applicable.
- Additional crane components and accessories (counterweights, boom, jibs, rigging, crane mats, etc.) that are not normally carried on a specific crane require additional handling and transport. Additional labor, equipment, and transport costs will be billed to the customer.
- Specific crane tasks or job sites can require written lift plans and/or site safety plans. Costs to complete written plans will be billed to the customer.
- Job site conditions and specific crane tasks can require additional personnel. Additional labor will be billed to the customer at the labor rates listed.
- Installation of tire chains, in route, on-site, or prior to loading, will be billed to the customer at the labor and equipment rates listed.
- Customer is responsible for providing adequate access to jobsites, this includes a safe adequate tow back to dry ground if the equipment is required to leave paved or graveled roadway. All tows will be paid by the customer. Equipment damage due to inadequate access will be the responsibility of the customer.
- Lowboy transport costs will include loading prior to departure and offloading upon return.
- Montana Department of Transportation oversize permits are required for the transport of all cranes on lowboys and for the travel of all truck cranes. All associated costs are billed to the customer. Written quotes are available upon request.
- Standard rigger's/hook insurance is \$ 1,000,000.00. Additional coverage requires quote from insurance underwriter and will be charged to the customer at cost plus 15%.
- A 20% Insurance surcharge will be assessed on all work involving machine and equipment moving requiring forking, jacking, rolling, or inside building placement. Written quotes are available upon request.
- Prevailing wage adjustments will be added to listed rates if applicable.
- Montana Crane Service, Ltd. reserves the right to change rates and policies without notice.
