SPECIAL NOTES & BILLING POLICIES

- Listed rates are for short term projects; discounted rates may apply depending on the duration of the project. Written and verbal quotes are available upon request for all your lifting needs.
- Montana Crane Service provides most spreader bars and rigging required at no additional charge.
- Cranes are priced by the hour based on all time onsite and round trip travel "portal to portal". Minimum round-trip charges will be applied per the following guidelines:
 - 2 hour minimum: boom trucks 14-ton to 40-ton, forklifts, transportation
 - 4 hour minimum: truck cranes 50-ton to 100-ton, rough terrain cranes, machinery moving
 - 8 hour minimum: truck cranes 140-ton to 220-ton
 - Additional/alternative minimums may apply to quoted work
- Overtime charges are added to the listed hourly rates under the following conditions:
 - All hours before 6 a.m. and after 6 p.m.; overnight work may incur additional charges beyond hourly overtime rates
 - All hours past 8 hours with one customer
 - All weekend and major holiday hours
- Manned standby time for cranes and equipment will be charged at 60% of the listed hourly rates; labor will be charged at the listed rate. Unmanned standby for equipment will be charged as applicable.
- Additional crane components and accessories (counterweights, boom, jibs, rigging, crane mats, etc.) that are not normally carried on a specific crane require additional handling and transport. Additional labor, equipment, and transport costs will be billed to the customer.
- Specific crane tasks or job sites can require written lift plans and/or site safety plans. Costs to complete written plans will be billed to the customer.
- Job site conditions and specific crane tasks can require additional personnel. Additional labor will be billed to the customer at the labor rates listed.
- Installation of tire chains in route, on-site, or prior to loading will be billed to the customer at the hourly labor and equipment rates listed.
- Customer is responsible for providing adequate access to jobsites; this includes a safe, adequate tow back to dry ground if the equipment is required to leave paved or graveled roadway. All tows will be paid by the customer. Equipment damage due to inadequate access will be the responsibility of the customer. A 20% off-road surcharge may be assessed on remote jobsites where travel off of maintained roads is required.
- Transport costs will include loading prior to departure and offloading upon return.
- Montana Department of Transportation oversize permits are required for the transport of all cranes on lowboys and for the travel of all truck cranes. Truck cranes 100-ton capacity and up require submittals and approval from the State; please allow two weeks for route turnaround. All associated costs are billed to the customer. Written quotes are available upon request.
- Standard riggers'/hook insurance is \$ 1,000,000.00. Additional coverage requires quote from insurance underwriter and will be charged to the customer at cost plus 15%.
- A 20% insurance surcharge will be assessed on all work involving machine and equipment moving requiring forking, jacking, rolling, or inside building placement. Written quotes are available upon request.
- Prevailing wage adjustments will be added to listed rates if applicable.
- Additional services available not listed include tower cranes, aerial work platforms, mobile storage, and bare rentals. Visit our website at www.montanacraneservice.com or call for pricing on additional services.
